

Letter from the Water Board

Summer is quickly approaching and construction on the water system is proceeding at a feverish pace. Three crews of Sunroc construction started installing waterlines on the west side of the mountain the last week of May and are anticipated to continue on the west side until the end of July. Additionally, one Sunroc crew has started installing waterlines on Blue Spruce. As crews complete their current assignments, they will be moving up the mountain to complete the project.

We would also like to welcome Build Inc. to the mountain. Build Inc. was awarded the contract to construct two new water tanks. They will begin construction as soon as possible. We do understand that construction may cause delays and inconveniences for many of us, but we do ask for your patience and understanding. Both Sunroc and Build Inc. have committed to working with the Water Company and The Timber Lakes Property Owners Association to minimize inconveniences that may be caused by the project. If you experience problems or have concerns, please contact us.

It has come to our attention that many owners are concerned about the condition of the roads once the project is completed. This is also of concern to the Water Company and is why the contract with Sunroc and Build Inc. requires them to return all roads to the condition they were found in prior to construction. Work on the roads in the upper area wherein pipes were replaced last year will resume as soon as the area is dried out enough to allow crews to successfully complete the work. Please understand that members of the Water Board either live in or own property in Timber Lakes and are therefore greatly interested in improving our community. The condition of the roads is as important to us as it is to all property owners.
